In the StartBook, we gathered the most important information and addresses relevant to new students of WULS-SGGW. Due to the current decisions of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education and sanitary recommendations regarding the increased epidemic risk, some assumptions may change. For current information on the functioning of the University, see the website www.sggw.pl/en/ and the websites of the Faculties.

Classes at the Warsaw University of Life Sciences will start on October 1 and for epidemic reasons they will be carried out in a hybrid form, i.e. both stationary and remotely.

For first-year students, all laboratory, clinical and practical classes will be carried out in a traditional way, in compliance with the applicable sanitary regime.

In order to ensure the highest safety standards, all lectures at the 1st and 2nd degree studies, as well as those classes, the implementation of which will not require a direct meeting with the lecturer and access to specialized laboratories, will be held on-line.

Meetings with deans and trainings will be organized for newly admitted students. During these meetings, information on the principles of study and organizational matters will be presented.

The official inauguration of the 2020/2021 academic year will take place on September 30 at 10 am. Due to epidemic reasons, we invite you to watch the on-line broadcast, which will be available on the YouTube platform of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences.

On-line dean's offices/On-site dean's offices


Electronic Student ID

To receive a student ID, log in to the on-line dean's office (ehms.sggw.pl) and pay a fee. Your photo will be transferred automatically from recruitment system. Dean's office will contact you when your ID is ready. Regularly it takes about 2 weeks.




Calendar 2020/21

Activation and access to Microsoft 365

Microsoft 365 service enables students to access to email, online classes and trainings, sending inquiries and applications to the online dean's office. To activate your account, go to https://konto.sggw.edu.pl/, select I forgot my password, and then enter the e-mail address provided during registration for studies in the e-mail address field. In response, an email with a link to reset the password will be sent to the provided address.

To access your MS Office 365 mailbox via a web browser, log on to https://poczta.sggw.edu.pl.

Student mailbox addresses have the following syntax: sXXXXXX@sggw.edu.pl where XXXXXX is the student book number (numer albumu) preceded by "0" to get 6 characters, for album number 1999 it will be s001999.

WI-FI

WULS-SGGW provides students with access to the EDUROAM (Education Roaming) wireless computer network. The network is available in most buildings on the campus.

Library

At WULS-SGGW, apart from the Main Library, there are faculty libraries, too. The student card serves also as the library card. You can find there approx. 550 thousand. volumes of books, magazines and special collections saved in paper form and approx. 300 thousand electronically stored units. Students and employees of WULS-SGGW have access to the world's scientific achievements on an ongoing basis.


